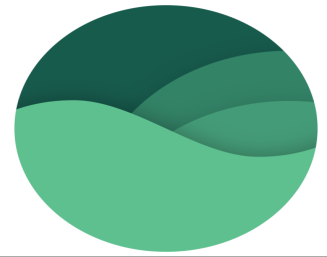

What to Bring: Sewing Machine in good working order, unless otherwise noted in the class description. Bring ¼" patchwork foot, extension cord, threaded bobbins, extra machine needles, manual and extra machine light bulb if you have one.

Basic Sewing Supplies: Bring basic sewing supplies as well as the specific supplies noted for individual classes: Sharps and quilting needles; neutral colored sewing thread for piecing; straight pins; fabric and paper scissors; thread nippers; seam ripper; thimbles; accurate rulers; glue stick; eraser; fabric marking pens and mechanical pencil; rotary cutter and new blades; cutting mat; plastic template material; and small bag to use for trash. Ironing stations will be provided in each classroom. Please mark each of your treasures with your name.

A class may be cancelled due to low registration in which case registrations will be transferred to next choice if available. We will be making 3 different projects in class today. I will show you different ways to make each project and you will leave with information to make more at home.

MUG RUGS: Bigger than a coaster, but smaller than a placemat. Supplies: scrap fabrics-small & larger pieces for backing. Small fabric pieces with saying or cute pictures Scrap batting (any kind) can be sewn together to make larger Thread for piecing & some different colors for decorative stitching.

FABRIC POSTCARDS: 4" x 6" cards & that can really be mailed. Supplies: scrap fabrics all sizes. Pretty threads for decorative stitches. Small ribbons, ric rac, etc. fusible web for appliqué and backing fabric I like Trans-web, Steam-a-seam 2, etc., permanent fabric markers, light beige fabric for backing

10 MINUTE TABLE RUNNER AND BEYOND: Need a quick gift or just an easy project to be sewing. Supplies: 1/3 yard (12") fabric for the feature fabric 1/2 yard (18") fabric for the border and back... bring 2 sets of fabrics in case you want to make more than one if we have time. Threads and 2 buttons to match fabrics.

This quilt is a WOW quilt.... Everyone will wonder how you made the block with just 5—5" squares!!! It is a beautiful blockthe technique will amaze you at how simply and quickly it goes together. Once you have made one...you will be addicted!!!This quilt is for an advanced beginner/intermediate level of quilter.

Supplies

5 coordinating fabrics – ½ yard of each

Cut 20---5" squares from each fabric---(this will make 20—9' x 9' blocks

1 ½ yards of white fabric—sashing—(can be white on white)

Cut 5 strips---3 ½" x WOF

Subcut 4 – 3 ½" x 12 ½" (rectangles)

Subcut 14 – 3 ½" x 9 ½" (rectangles)

Cut 4 strips---1 ½" x WOF

Subcut 38 -- 1 ½" x 3 ½" (rectangles)

Cut 18 strips---1 ½" x WOF

1 yard of Accent Fabric—that will coordinate with fabric for blocks.

Cut 9 strips – 1 ½" x WOF (sashing)

Cut 7 strips – 2 ¼" x WOF (Binding)

3 ¼ yards for Backing Fabric

Thread (White will be fine).

You will also need: Sewing machine, extra bobbins (already wound with thread), seam ripper, scissors, and pins. A ¼" quilting foot is very helpful but not required. Ironing boards, irons and cutting equipment will be provided.

BARN QUILT SQUARE

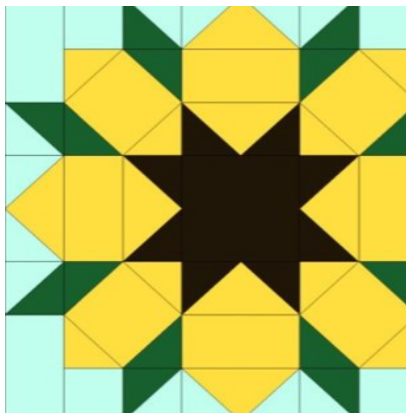

We will be painting a 2 foot X 2 foot board that has already been primed and painted on the back side and primed on the front. You will have the opportunity to draw a pattern on the board of your choice.

Carol will have samples for you to look at to see



which one you would like to paint,. You can choose from different colors of paint that are provided. You will have your board finished when you leave except the varnish which has to be done 24 hours later. You will be taking home a small amount of varnish so you can finish at home. Supplies provided by instructor—just bring a small jar with lid for varnish. Also you might want to place an old sheet in the trunk of your car to lay the board on to take home.

Size 35" x 34"

We will be making this using the appliqué method. This pattern includes the full size pattern for tracing on Trans Web. I will show you how to piece the background and borders. Then you will place your pattern pieces on that background. We will then iron those in place and begin the quilting process. For mine, I layered and quilted using the Horizontal lines quilting method which tacks down the appliqué and looks great once completed. This

eliminates the need to do machine quilting around each piece of fabric.

Fabric Requirements:

Ellie, grass, & sun 10 – 15 Fat Eights or scraps

Borders and Binding

- Inner border 1/4 yd
- Middle border 1/8 yd
- Outer Border & binding 1/2 yd

Backing fabric 1 yd

Background 5 coordinating Fat Quarters

I will make a kit with the pattern pieces traced on Trans Web. Cost \$5

Additional supplies

Paper scissors

Walking foot with guide and thread for quilting/ iron and pressing mat.
